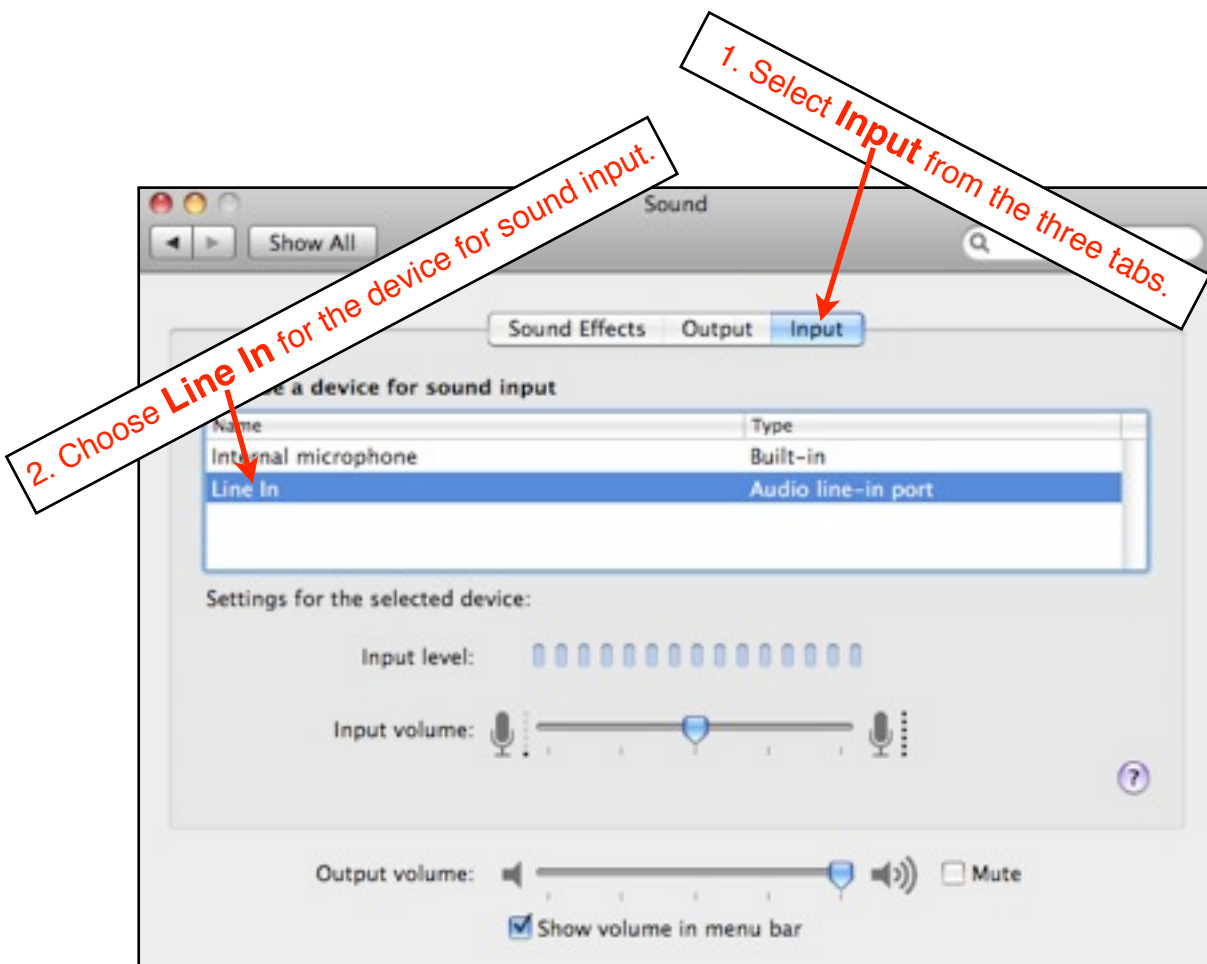


Creating Audio Files from External Sources

Preliminary set-up

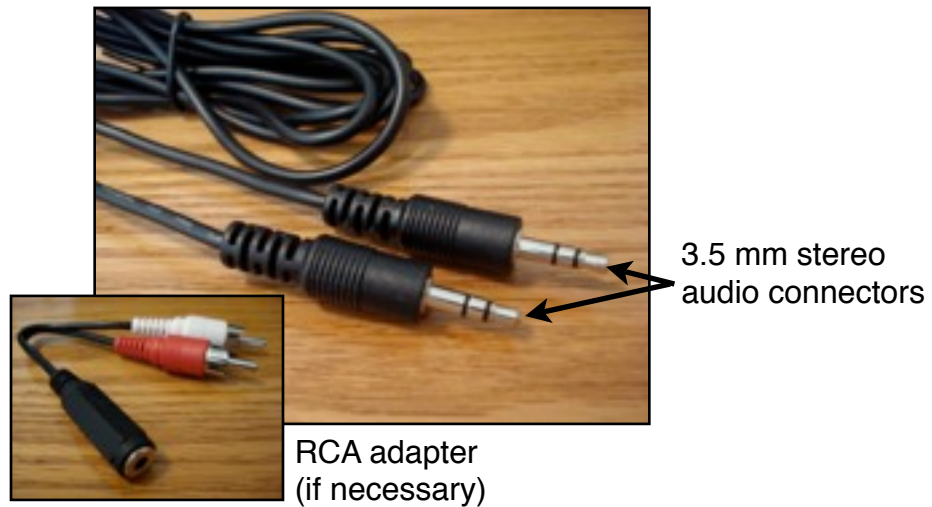
1. Under the Apple icon  go to **System Preferences...**

2. Click on **Sound**

3. Connect proper cables from headphone jack on device to microphone jack on computer.



Creating Audio Files from External Sources

Recording audio

Using GarageBand

- * Open GarageBand
- * Select Create New Music Project ---> Title your project
- * Track ---> Delete Track
- * Track ---> New Track ---> Select "Real Instrument Track"



- * Begin to record by clicking the play button on the device and the **red** record button in GarageBand and do the same to end the recording



- * Edit to your pleasure...
- * Share ---> (Send or Export or Burn)
- * Burn to audio CD

Using Quicktime Pro

- * Open Quicktime
- * File ---> New Audio Recording
- * Begin to record by clicking the play button on the device and the **red** record button in Quicktime Pro and do the same to end the recording



- * Edit to your pleasure...
- * File ---> Export... (or File ---> Share...)
- * Burn to audio CD or send to iTunes to burn to audio CD
