

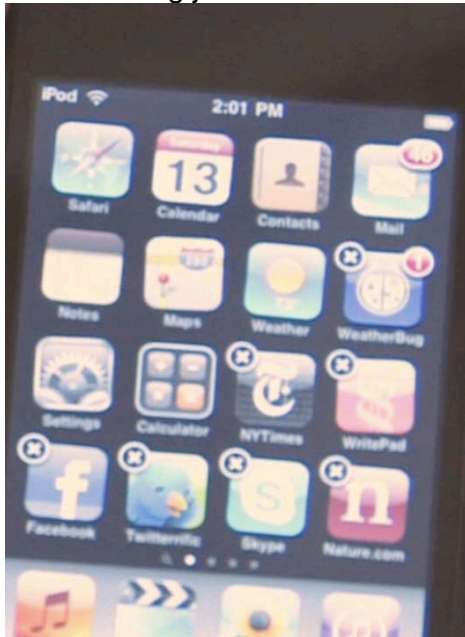
How to Delete Apps in iTunes and your iPod

Here is a question many ask....

I have 100 or so apps downloaded into iTunes, and I've deleted some from the iPod Touch, when after trying the items out I decided I did not want to keep them.

Is there a way to display in iTunes which apps have been uninstalled from a portable device so that I can go delete them the rest of the way off the computer?

1. To delete a App on your iPod you only have to hold down the App you no longer want and they will all start to wiggle. There will be an "X" on the Apps and all you have to do is hit the App you do not want and it will come up and ask you if you want to delete it. When you are done deleting just hit the button button and it stops the Apps from wiggling and you are done.



2. To get it out of iTunes, you need to open launch iTunes and connect your iPod to your computer.

3. It will then start Syncing your iPod.

4. When you hit the Applications tab you will see all the Apps you have Synced on your iPod.



5. To have an App not show up on your Mac, just unclick it. If you want to take it off of your hard drive forever, just go up to the Applications on the left side and click on the one you no longer want and hit delete. It will ask if you are sure you want to delete it, just say, "Remove."
